

Assessments

WHAT IS AN ASSESSMENT?

An assessment is our first step in getting to know you and your child or person served. The information we gather during the assessment helps us know what kinds of services are needed. We need to know what causes the problem behavior. We do this in our center because this is a safe place to conduct this assessment. A clinician prepares an individualized assessment plan. This plan includes:

- > Review of prior records
- > Administration of standardized tests
- > Caregiver interviews and
- > We explore situations that trigger problem behavior

We will use information from your interview to develop an individualized assessment where we will present situations such as having to wait for a preferred item or being told “no” or asked to complete a challenging task. We will use the information we gather from this assessment to develop a treatment that addresses your child or person’s served specific reason for problem behavior. The assessment lays the foundation for providing effective treatment services and building a meaningful partnership between our clinical team and your family.

WHY IS YOUR ASSESSMENT IMPORTANT?

Throughout assessment, you will have opportunities to ask questions and learn how ABA treatment works. Based on assessment results, recommendations are made for the number of treatment hours your child needs and the number of staff who will support them. Caregiver participation ensures our assessment findings reflect the challenges you are experiencing in the home and community.

At the conclusion of assessment, the following occurs:

- > A formal report is written
- > You will review this report
- > The final report is submitted to your funder

Authorization for treatment services is based on the recommendations within this report. There are strict timelines for submission of this report. Delays to the completion of assessment may result in delays to the initiation of treatment services.
